Please read these terms & conditions (“Terms”) before proceeding as they explain the legal framework for the information on this website. By accessing this website, you are deemed to have read and accepted these Terms and it is your responsibility to be aware of, and to observe, the applicable laws and regulations of any relevant jurisdiction. Hg reserves the right to modify these Terms at any time.

Privacy Statement

Hg respects your privacy and recognises the importance of protecting the personal information held on the Hive.

This statement sets out the rights that you have in respect of your personal information related to your membership of the Hive. It also details how and what personal information we collect, what purposes we use that information for and who we share that information with.

Information collected via Hive

Hg collects information from you when you interact with us, e.g. when:

- you are an actual or potential consultant and or business partner;
- you are a portfolio company employee;
- you visit Hive;
- you send us an email;
- you upload information such as your profile photo; you include your job title and name on Hive;
- you sign up to our news notifications via the Hive registration form;
- you engage with us on social media;
- you contact us by any means with queries, interests or concerns;

- you attend, one of our forums or networking dinners;
- you choose to complete surveys we send you; or
- you choose to provide us with your personal information during business encounters, for example completing your profile page in Hive

In its basic form the information that Hg collects on the Hive includes; names, email addresses and job titles. To utilise extended features in Hive, you will be invited to provide further personal information regarding your profile, examples of which may be, provision of a photograph, skills and expertise. The provision of this information is purely optional and of your choice. By providing personal data on the Hive, you consent to Hg holding and processing such data relating to you.

Hg forums and networking events

Hg collects information on past and future attendees and speakers for our portfolio forums and networking events, including name, title, photo and biography. This information is kept in line with our data retention policy and is not shared with any third party for marketing purposes.

Who we share your information with

Hg Group

Hg shares your information within the Hg Group.

Service providers

Hg shares your information with third parties, including Hg group entities, and service providers who need your information in the course of providing services related to the Hive. Where a third party is used for these specified reasons, we will ensure that each such service provider has agreed to protect and maintain the confidentiality and security of information Hg shares with them.

Third party IT providers

Hg engages trusted third-party IT providers. Information will only be transferred to third party IT providers where reasonably necessary to enable us to fulfil the purposes set out in this privacy notice and in the delivery of the Hive platform and we will ensure that those suppliers are subject to agreements regarding the protection of your information.

Transferring information internationally

The Hive platform provider is a designated “processor” (under the GDPR). Your information will be transferred to a jurisdiction outside the European Economic Area (the “EEA”) – the US or other jurisdictions outside of the EEA. A jurisdiction like the US may not offer the same level of data protection as in your home jurisdiction and may not be regarded by the European Commission as providing an adequate level of data protection. Where your information is transferred from within the EEA to a location outside of the EEA, care is taken to ensure that the transfer is subject to appropriate safeguards (which may be contractual in nature) in accordance with data protection laws. Where required or permitted by law

Deletions will be carried out in accordance with our retention schedule. Any information stored in hard copy format (in paper form) is treated as confidential and will be shredded at the point of deletion.

Your rights

Cookies

These choices are not tied to any personally identifiable information. Cookies are encrypted.
